- -Submit proof of enrollment:
 - 1. High School/ College Transcript or
 - 2. High School/ College schedule

TOPIC: Submit a typed, double spaced, 1 page, word essay (1 page, no picture) on:

How do "People to People programs work with your associations Sister-Cities and what has been a program your association has done. Recount an experience you have had.

Each Application and Essay will be graded out of 100 points.

- 50 pts. Essay
- 20 pts. Application
- 10 pts. Sister-City Recommendation
- 10 pts. Teacher/Counselor Recommendation
- 10pts. Proof of current college enrollment.
